



Policy for Volunteer Training Support

As a way of showing the club's appreciation to its Volunteers, ASA would like to offer training support to regular helpers.

Periodically, ASA will organise free training including ski set-up and lift operation. In addition, the club is keen for Volunteers to have the opportunity to develop their skills and knowledge and has set aside funds to provide financial support for this training.

In order to make this fair to all, the club has put in place a few requirements:

- The course must be relevant to the ASA ski sessions. Some examples are: BASI, SSCD, SSE, First Aid, Safeguarding
- A Volunteer who has attended at least 12 ASA sessions is eligible for a contribution of up to 50% of the course cost. Occasionally a higher contribution is available, this is at the discretion of the Committee.
- For Volunteers who have been with the club for a shorter period of time, we can offer 25% funding providing:
 - The Volunteer has attended a minimum of 9 monthly sessions, Or
 - If less than 9 sessions, the Volunteer should inform the Club that they wish to undertake the training and the club will reimburse the Volunteer when they have reached the 9-month point
